<b>RYLA's conducted</b>	150
<b>Focus on</b>	Youth between 14 to 30 years.
<b>Methodology</b>	Four Important Topics were selected and standardized Self Awareness/team Building/ Emotional Quotient/ Value System
<b>Target Audience</b>	Low Income School. Children, College Youth Physically Handicapped, Visually Impaired, Street Children, Institutions for economically weaker section Refugee Camp Students, Management Graduates,
<b>100% RYLA</b>	Krupanidhi Graduate College became probably the World's First Institution to have all its students attending a RYLA, 2000 Students from the Institution participated.
<b>Multi-District</b>	There was one Multi District RYLA between District 3180 And our District 3190.
<b>Rotarians Participation</b>	In most of the RYLA's Rotarians were either the Faculty &/or organized the RYLA.
<b>Outside Assistance</b>	The District took the service of an excellent Youth Training Organization called Buoyancee, who have had more than 200000 students trained over the last 12 years. More than 15 Trainers from the organization took part in our RYLA's.
<b>Cost of RYLA</b>	The cost was around US \$ 40 per RYLA for an average group of 60 students.
<b>Who paid for it</b>	The individual clubs, Corporate Sponsors, etc helped us to Cover the cost.
<b>Youth Benefited</b>	More than 10,000 youngsters have been exposed to RYLA's
